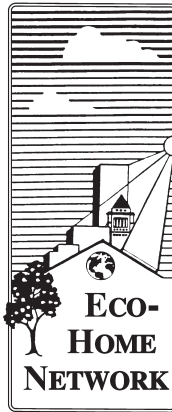

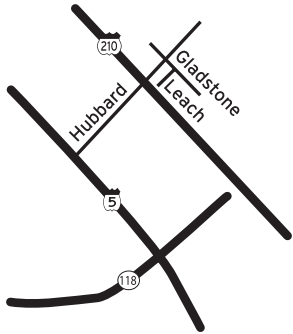

210 WEST, HUBBARD ST exit. Turn right on HUBBARD ST, Turn right on GLADSTONE AVE, Turn right on LEACH ST.

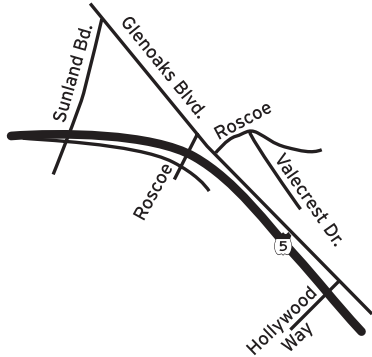


**Mackey Residence**

**Directions:**

5 Freeway NORTH from Los Angeles, HOLLYWOOD WAY exit. Right on N HOLLYWOOD WAY, Left on GLENOAKS BLVD, Right on ROSCOE BLVD, Right on VALECREST DR

5 Freeway South, SUNLAND BLVD exit, straight across SUNLAND BLVD. left on ROSCOE, Right on GLENOAKS BL., Left on ROSCOE, again, Right on VALECREST Dr.

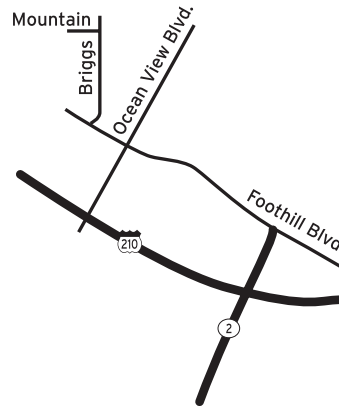


**Williams Baumgart House**

**Directions:**

2 Freeway north from Los Angeles exit at Foothill Blvd., Left onto FOOHILL BLVD, Right on BRIGGS AVE, Left on MOUNTAIN AVE.

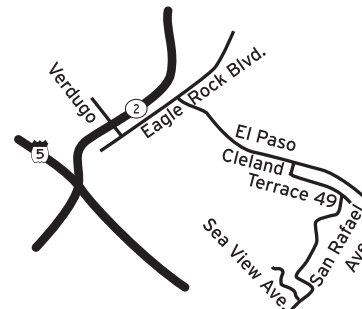
201 Freeway exit at Ocean View Blvd., go up the hill, left on Foothill Blvd., right on Briggs Ave., Left on Mountain Ave.



**Schneider Residence**  
4113 Sea View Ave.  
Mt. Washington

**Directions**

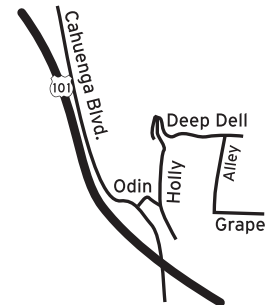
Exit Glendale (2) Freeway at Verdugo Rd. and follow the direction signs toward Eagle Rock Blvd. Turn Left onto Eagle Rock Blvd. and get in the extreme right lane. Turn Right onto El Paso Dr. (traffic light) heading east for about 1 mi. Turn Right onto Cleland Ave. (stop sign) for one short block. Turn Left onto Terrace 49 (stop sign) for one block. Turn Right onto San Rafael Ave. (stop sign) and follow it up on what is known to locals as "the Corkscrew." At the second Stop sign on San Rafael ave, turn HARD right onto Sea View Avenue (not the Lane) and go about 1-1/2 blocks to 4113. It's the Santa Fe style on the left (sort of straight ahead) as Sea View Ave turns to the right. Parking is best just around this bend on either side of Sea View Ave.



**Grodner Residence**  
6311 Grape Place

**Directions**

From the 101, exit at Cahuenga Blvd. Turn NORTH onto Cahuenga (a left if you take the 101 South, a right if you take the 101 North). Make your first RIGHT onto Odin St. and go past (the 1st) Deep Dell Pl. to the bottom of Odin. Make a LEFT onto Holly Dr. and go to the end of the street at the circle. Make a SHARP RIGHT onto Deep Dell Pl. and drive for about 30 seconds. During a leftward curve there is a telephone pole with 3 yellow stripes and an alley entrance on the right. Make a RIGHT into the alley and take it to the end. 6311 is the large green house.... the solar panels on the roof will be visible. Feel free to park in or in front of either of the home's driveways and please be careful not to block access for my neighbors.
